Banana Chocolate Mousses

80g dark chocolate
10g marg
3 tblsp caster sugar
2 eggs
150ml double cream
1 ripe banana
4 serving glasses

Method

1. Break 75g of chocolate into a small bowl and melt over boiling water. Add the marg and leave until melted.
2. In another bowl whisk 3tblsps sugar with the egg yolks until pale and creamy.
3. Using another small bowl whisk 50mls of cream until thick
4. In another bowl whisk the egg whites until stiff.
5. Gently fold the chocolate mixture into the egg yolk mixture, then add the cream and egg whites.
6. Slice the bananas and place in the glasses and top with the chocolate mixture.
7. Cover with clingfilm and thoroughly chill.
8. Lightly whip the remaining cream and swirl on top. Grate the remaining chocolate and sprinkle on top.

To make the banana layer even more delicious – dissolve 50g sugar in $1\frac{1}{2}$ tblsp water and boil for 3 mins until syrupy, stir all the time then add 1 tblsp strong coffee. Leave to cool then add the banana slices and place this mixture in the glasses.
