YUMMY CHOCOLATE FUDGE

75g butter or marg
500g chocolate – dark or milk
1 tin of condensed milk
2 teaspoons flavouring (vanilla, orange or peppermint essence)

1. Line 20cm square tin with cling film.
2. Break chocolate into small pieces and place in pan with butter and milk.
3. Heat **gently** stirring all the time until chocolate and butter have melted and the mixture is smooth. DO NOT ALLOW TO BOIL.
4. Take pan off the heat - add the flavouring and beat until the mixture thickens.
5. Pour into prepared tin and smooth top.
6. Leave the mixture to cool in fridge for at least 1 hour.
7. Tip out onto board and cut into squares.
8. Eat and enjoy!
