Valentine's Day on Sunday!! – Why not surprise the one you love with a cake!

Ingredients

100g SR flour
1/2 tsp baking powder
100g soft margarine
100g caster sugar
2 eggs
17 x 28cm tin (swiss roll tin)
greaseproof paper to line tin

50g soft margarine mixed with 100g icing sugar to make butter cream

4tbsp red jam
4tbsp sugar strands or desiccated coconut

4tbsp icing sugar
Few drops of red cake colouring

Heart shaped cutter or card template to cut round.

Method

1. Line tin with greaseproof paper
2. Oven on 170°C, Gas 5
3. Place all cake ingredients in bowl and beat until soft and creamy.
4. Place mixture in tin and bake for 20mins.
5. Remove from tin and cool.
6. Cut cake into heart shapes using cutter or template.
7. Spread jam on the sides of the cakes then roll in coconut or sugar strands.
8. Place butter cream in piping bag fitted with a small star nozzle and pipe round the top edge of the cakes.
9. Mix icing sugar with a few drops of colouring and enough water to make a stiff paste.

Pour over tops of cakes. Allow 5mins for icing to set then enjoy!

PANCAKE DAY TUESDAY 16TH FEBRUARY

Ingredients

For the pancake mixture:

- 2 cups flour
- 2 cups milk
- 2 eggs (beaten)
- 1/3 cup butter (melted)
- 2 tablespoons sugar (optional)
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt

Instructions:

In a large bowl combine the flour, milk, beaten eggs, melted butter, sugar, baking powder and salt until just blended.

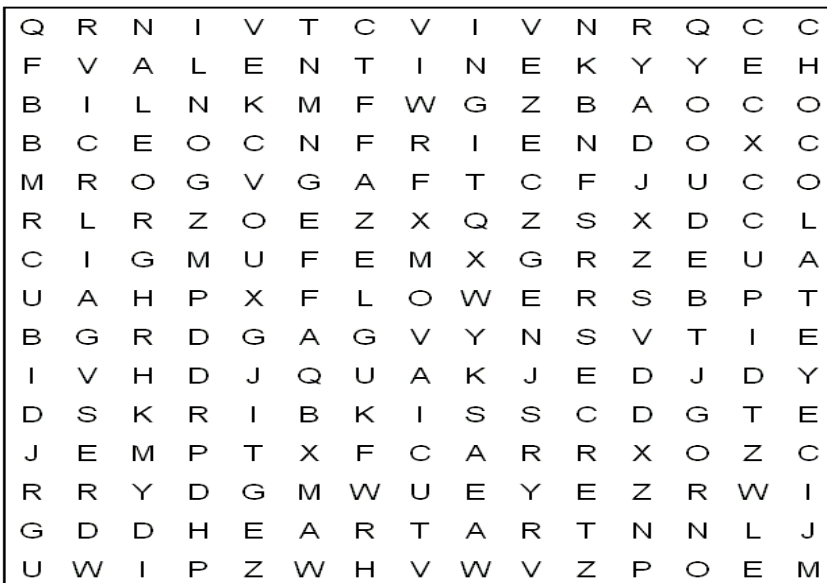
Preheat a lightly greased griddle or frying pan. Pour about 1/4 cup of batter into pan for each pancake. Cook until pancakes begin to bubble. Flip once and cook for 1 to 2 minutes longer.

Serve with maple syrup, jam or fruit.
